

House Wine

201. (Red) Rouge Passion - Coteaux du Liban lebanon 175ML / 250ML / BOTTLE

£3.75 / £4.75 / £14.25

A blend of a grape variety of cabernet- sauvignon, syrah, Carignan and Grenache with a ruby colour and complex fruity aromas.

204. (White) Blanc Du Clos - Coteaux du Liban lebanon 175ML / 250ML / BOTTLE

£3.75 / £4.75 / £14.25

A blend of grape variety of Chardonnay and viognier with yellow colour and an intense Exotic aroma .

207. (Rose) Rose Desir - Coteaux Du Liban lebanon 175ML / 250ML / BOTTLE

A blend of a variety of Syrah, Carignan, Cinsault and Grenache, with intense floral aroma.

Red wine

304. Ksara Le Prieure (Lebanon) £17.25

A bright intense ruby red wine with an exotic fruity aroma along with spicy and licorice notes making it a wine to remember. It is based on Cinsault and help up with some Syrah and Cabernet-Sauvignon, goes perfectly well with lamb and stews.

305. Red Classic - Domaine Massaya (Lebanon) £22.25

Cinsault, cabernet sauvignon & syrah. This Rhone/ Bordeaux Blend is Packed with Juicy Plumy fruit.

306. Chateau Musar Jeune (Lebanon) £21.25

From world famous Lebanese estate Chateau Musar, this deep-coloured, velvety, unoaked red offers intense aromas and flavours of blackcurrants, red cherries, peppery cinnamon spice and hints of violets. Enjoy with roast lamb,

308. Ksara Reserve Du Couvent (Lebanon) £22.25

Superbly balanced, this dark ruby wine, from Cabernet-Sauvignon, Syrah and Carignan combines elegance with a lingering delicacy. Cultivated in oaken casks, it can be easily kept for 3 to 5 years and goes perfectly with roasted or grilled red meat and game.

309. La Campagne Syrah, Pays d'Oc (France) £16.00

The Syrah grape thrives in the sunny Languedoc region and produces a rich, juicy wine with soft tannins and a spicy palate.

310. Solandia Nero d'Avola Sicilia (Italy) £14.75

This wonderful indigenous grape produces Shiraz like flavours and spice with the extra bit of juicy fruit, liquorice and vanilla.

311. Rare Vineyards Pinot Noir, Vin de France (France) £17.45

From the foothills of the Pyrenees, soft, lightly oaked cherries and blueberries with a hint of spice.

312. The Gourmet Shiraz (South Australian) £14.95

Fruit flavour with crisp freshness backed by Chardonnay to fill out the middle palate

313. Kleine Zalze Cabernet Sauvignon, Coastal Region (South Africa) £17.95

A pronounced classic style, full of rich blackcurrant flavours, hints of cedarwood and vanilla-oak.

315. Los Romeros Merlot Central Valley (Chile) £14.75

Soft, warm and smooth red with lots of blackcurrant and plum fruits and a dash of spice.

316. Montepulciano D'Abruzzo Collezione (Italy) £14.75

Grown on the eastern Adriatic coastline giving an intensity of colour and heady bouquet of violets and oranges.

317. Don Jacobo Rioja Crianza Tinto, Bodegas Corral (Spain) £23.50

Abundant bright raspberry aromas mingle with sumptuous cherries and layered with a creamy barrique character.

White Wine

320. Chateau Musar Jeune (Lebanon) £21.25

From world famous Lebanese estate Chateau Musar, this crisp, aromatic, unoaked white offers enticing aromas and flavours of pineapples, citrus and jasmine flowers. An excellent match for grilled fish.

321. Blanc de L'observatoire - Ksara (Lebanon) £17.25

Medium Bodied with a subtle fruit and soft finish.

322. Blanc De Blanc Ksara (Lebanon) £22.25

The very noble Sauvignon, Sémillon and Chardonnay constitutes the basis of this elegant and subtle wine. It is vatted for several months in French oak-wood casks before it is bottled. it is bottled.

323. La Campagne Viognier, Pays d'Oc (France) £ 16.00

Dry with all the classic characteristics of the Viognier grape, exhibiting peaches, dried apricots and floral aromas.

324. Mâcon-Villages, Beauvernon, Thorin (France) £21.85

A classic style, pale yellow with flowery, apple aromas, a strikingly fruity taste and a refreshing acidity.

325. Sancerre, Les Collinettes, Joseph Mellot (France) £25.75

Stylish and crisp aromas of gooseberries and powerful fruit flavours, linked with a clean finish, from one of the finest and most dynamic producers.

326. Chablis Gloire de Chablis, J. Moreau et Fils (France) £24.00

A traditional Chablis, dry, flinty and elegant with distinctive Chardonnay character on the finish.

327. The Gourmet Chardonnay, (South Australia) £14.95

Fruit-driven Chardonnay, unoaked with zesty, citrusy fruit and a structure made for food.

329. Los Romeros Sauvignon Blanc, Central Valley (Chile) £14.75

Fragrant aromas of lemon and gooseberries with a zesty finish.

330. Kleine Zalze Bush Vines Chenin Blanc, Stellenbosch (South Africa) £15.55

Soft and creamy, a hint of ripe exotic fruit and a delicious vanilla sweetness.

331. Pinot Grigio di Pavia, Collezione Marchesini (Italy) £15.95

Lovely buttery, crisp and dry style with typical pear fruit from this area of central northern Italy in the southern section of Lombardy. .

Rose Wine

333. Nakad Rose - Coteau de la Bekaa (Lebanon) £21.25

A Delicious fruity rose wine with an attractive blend of cinsault and carignan grapes.

334. Vendange White Zinfandel, California (USA) £17.25

A brief time with juice and skin together gives this delicate colour, delicious strawberry aroma and zingy freshness.

335. Los Romeros Merlot Rosé, Central Valley (Chile) £14.75

Bright raspberry and strawberry aromas with pleasant blackcurrant flavours make this a soft easy drinking wine.

Reserved Wines

336. Chateau Musar 1991 (Lebanon) £125.00

Cabernet Sauvignon from Kefraya's rocky soil, very deep purple, sweet, lovely crisp flavour, excellent tannins and acidity. End taste of violets and blackcurrants.

337. Comte de M 2000 (Lebanon) £81.25

An opaque dark purple colour, preceded by a complex aroma of black fruit jam, tobacco, cedar and a spicy mineral note. In the mouth a marvelous texture is detected: full-bodied, creamy with well melted tannins, very elegant.

338. Chateau Thomas 2001(Lebanon) £45.25

Nobles grapes aged 18 months in new French oak Barrels, a refined wine with great personality.

339. Louis Jadot 1998 (France) £98.00

This exceptional site yields a wine of sumptuous brilliance and complexity, powerfully structured and richly fruited. The aromatic Pinot Noir bouquet and deep, layered berry and oak flavours culminate in a seductive, persistent finish.

340. Château Lagrange 1999 St-Julien, 3ème Grand Cru Classé £95.00

Opulent, concentrated, deeply-coloured wine from a lesser-known but high quality property in St-Julien. Perfumed, and with low acidity the suppleness of this wine is its charm. Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot, Cabernet Franc
